
CCPR/CIE Joint Workshop 100 Years of $V(\lambda)$ and Future of Photometry

First Announcement

This workshop is co-organized by Consultative Committee for Photometry and Radiometry ($\underline{\text{CCPR}}$) and International Commission on Illumination ($\underline{\text{CIE}}$), and will be held in conjunction with CCPR 26th meeting and CCPR Working Group meetings at BIPM (June 4 – 7) and CIE Division 1 and Division 2 annual meetings in Paris (May 30-June 1, proposed).

The workshop will commemorate 100th anniversary of $V(\lambda)$, overview the history of spectral luminous efficiency functions and CIE colorimetry, and introduce the cone fundamentals published by CIE (2006, 2015), then will discuss the future of photometry and colorimetry with cone-fundamental-based spectral luminous efficiency functions and color-matching functions.

Session 3 Photometry with Cone Fundamentals

Session 4 Discussion for future directions for photometry and colorimetry
