## CIE Australia President's Report 2024 AGM

This will be my ninth and final CIE Australia President's report, and once again I am pleased to report that this has again been a year of further consolidation and improvement.

The day after our AGM we will hold our sixth annual CIE Australia Lighting Research Conference, hybrid format at the University of Melbourne and online. There will be again a strong number of presentations from a variety of topics, with those online logging in from Australia, UK, Belgium, USA, Italy, Saudi Arabia, Denmark and Malaysia) and other attendees also from outside Australia.

Holding a conference like this on an annual basis goes a long way to showing us to be an organised and active organisation. The regular communications sent to the CIE Australia News List (which includes CIE newsletters, announcements of conferences and workshops, announcements of new publications, etc.) also helps with this.

The afternoon after our AGM we will also be holding a now-regular Research Students' Workshop, which helps to connect university students, supervisors, industry and the wider research community.

Last year there was the 30<sup>th</sup> Quadrennial Session of the CIE in Ljubljana, Slovenia. This is the main plenary event of the CIE where all Divisions meet together and we had a changing over of Officers of the Commission for the new quadrennium. The incoming CIE President is Dr Jennifer Veitch (CA) and the outgoing President Dr Peter Blattner is now the Past President. I am pleased to announce that I have also take on the role of CIE Vice-President Technical for the 2023-2027 quadrennium.

This initiative, which is now annual, is another additional benefit to membership.

Many thanks also to Vice President Steve Coyne, Treasurer Eric Southgate, Secretary Gillian Isoardi, IT Officer Adrian Cupitt, and general Exec members Wenye Hu and Maitreyee Roy for their great support over the past year.

I have served two terms of four years plus an additional year now, and I feel that I have achieved what I set out to achieve in the nine years. Some key achievements include:

- Creating a CIE Australia News list to distribute information and provide the feeling of connection.
- Maintaining the website for providing information and coordination of events.
- Creating the now-annual CIE Australia Lighting Research Conference, which
  connects the lighting community with researchers and industry in Australia and
  provides an additional revenue stream for CIE Australia.
- We have made changes to the CIE Australia Rules (our constitution) which added Student Membership and added the positions of Officers without portfolio to the CIE Australia Executive. The latter helps with the capacity of the Executive to grow the organisation and will help with succession planning.
- We continue to represent the interests of Australia strongly in the CIE General Assembly.

I am confident that CIE Australia will continue to grow and remain strong into the future and I look forward to working with whomever will be the next President.
