



Use of CIE Australia name and logo for CIE Australia members

These guidelines outline the permitted use of the CIE Australia name and logo on official documentation and in correspondence.

1. Official documentation

This includes but is not limited to company websites and letterhead documents. Members may use the CIE Australia name and logo as specified in the table below. The column "Max page %" specifies the maximum percentage area that the statement and/or logo may comprise of a document page or web page.

| Membership type | Use of logo | Use of name | Example text | Max. page % |
|------------------------------|-------------|-------------|--|----------------|
| Sustaining Organisational | Yes | Yes | ABC Company is a sustaining organisational member of CIE Australia | 10% |
| Organisational | No | Yes | ABC Company is an organisational member of CIE Australia | 4% |
| Individual | No | Yes | Member, CIE Australia | 2% |

2. In correspondence

Members of CIE Australia may identify themselves as members of CIE Australia in correspondence as a means of establishing a professional credential. However, members should not imply that they are acting or speaking on behalf of CIE Australia unless sanctioned by a CIE Australia general meeting or by the CIE Australia Executive.

3. Special cases and considerations

Use of the CIE Australia name and/or logo may be granted in special cases by the CIE Australia Executive and, in some cases, may require ratification by a CIE Australia general meeting. To apply for special consideration please contact president@cie.org.au.
